KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Rose Lavelle



UW–Madison alumna Rose Lavelle captured the attention of the world during her star turn on the US National Women's soccer team, which won the Women's World Cup in 2019.

Lavelle started six of seven games in the international competition and scored three goals—one of which secured victory for the US in the World Cup Final. She was awarded the Bronze Ball as the third most-outstanding player in the tournament. FIFA, the international governing body that oversees the Women's World Cup, named her the sixth best player in the world, while members of the International Federation of Professional Footballers voted to include her on an all-star team of the best female soccer players of 2019.

As a Badger, Lavelle was a four-year starter, 2015 MAC Hermann Trophy semifinalist, two-time Big Ten midfielder of the year, and Big Ten freshman of the year. The National Soccer Coaches Association of America named her a First Team All-American.

Lavelle's play blends elements of ruthless resilience and an unmatched elegance, traits that have led to a strong following globally. She's expanded her fan base with a fun-loving social media presence, which has led to notoriety for her English bulldog Wilma J. Wrinkles, and a ranking as the second most-powerful athlete endorser under the age of 25 by Nielsen Sports. Lavelle is now a midfielder for the English team Manchester City.

A native of Cincinnati, she earned a bachelor's degree from UW–Madison in sociology in 2017.

CHANCELLOR

Rebecca M. Blank



Rebecca M. Blank became chancellor of the University of Wisconsin–Madison in July 2013. Since then, she has presided over a major effort to expand access and improve educational outcomes, making sure that students are prepared to succeed in a rapidly changing economy. At the same time, she has worked to maintain the university's position as a global leader in innovation and research, nurturing entrepreneurship and driving economic development.

Blank is an internationally respected economist who has also spent time in Washington, DC, working in three different administrations. Most recently, she served as Deputy Secretary and Acting Secretary of the US Department of Commerce under President Obama.

She also brings strong academic credentials to the position of chancellor. She served as dean and professor of public policy and economics in the Gerald R. Ford School of Public Policy at the University of Michigan from 1999 to 2008. In her role as dean, she launched such innovations as interdisciplinary graduate programs and an undergraduate public policy major. Earlier in her career, she was a member of the faculty at Northwestern University and Princeton University.

A native Midwesterner, Blank earned an undergraduate degree in economics from the University of Minnesota and a doctoral degree in economics from MIT.

Blank is a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and has received numerous awards, including the Daniel Patrick Moynihan Prize. This prize is given by the American Academy of Political and Social Science to individuals who use social science research to inform public policy while also contributing to the public discourse on society's most pressing issues.

Blank is a frequent speaker on the importance of public research universities. She has been part of a vital national conversation about how to keep these institutions financially stable and thriving.

Her leadership has reinforced UW-Madison's position as one of the world's top universities—a center for education, discovery, and research, committed to sharing knowledge and innovation that improves lives in Wisconsin and around the globe.

PROVOST

John Karl Scholz



John Karl Scholz began serving as provost in August 2019 after six years as the dean of the College of Letters & Science at UW–Madison. Scholz is also the Nellie June Gray Professor of Economic Policy in the Department of Economics, which he joined in 1988.

From 1997 to 1998, Scholz was the deputy assistant secretary for tax analysis at the US Treasury Department, and from 1990 to 1991 he was a senior staff economist at the Council of Economic Advisors. Scholz directed the Institute for Research on Poverty at UW–Madison from 2000 to 2004.

Professor Scholz is an internationally respected economist whose work on household saving, low-wage labor markets, financial barriers to higher education, and bankruptcy has appeared in leading economics journals.

A native of Nebraska, Scholz graduated from Carleton College in Northfield, Minnesota, and earned his doctorate from Stanford University.

HONORARY DEGREE

Dr. V. Craig Jordan



Groundbreaking cancer researcher Dr. V. Craig Jordan is considered the "Father of Tamoxifen," the therapeutic drug credited with saving millions of cancer patients and preventing the development of breast cancer in women at high risk. Jordan was the first researcher to identify the drug's breast cancer prevention properties—work he began years ago while leading UW's breast cancer research efforts.

Jordan earned a bachelor's degree (1969) and a doctorate (1973) in pharmacology from the University of Leeds in England. In 1977, he spent time as a visiting investigator in the Department of Human Oncology at UW–Madison. He joined the faculty of UW–Madison in 1980. In 1985, Jordan was promoted to professor of human oncology and pharmacology and director of the Breast Cancer Research and Treatment Program at the University of Wisconsin Comprehensive Cancer Center. He remained at UW–Madison until 1993.

After UW, Jordan held faculty positions and key cancer research-related leadership positions at Northwestern University, the Fox Chase Cancer Center in Philadelphia, and Georgetown University. Currently, he is a professor of breast medical oncology at the MD Anderson Cancer Center at the University of Texas in Houston. He is also the Dallas/Fort Worth Living Legend Chair of Cancer Research.

Jordan's career focuses on the treatment of hormone receptorpositive breast cancer, the most common subtype of breast cancer, and specifically on the development of selective estrogen receptor modulators, or SERMs. These medicines, discovered during Jordan's tenure at Wisconsin, have improved women's health by treating and preventing breast cancer and osteoporosis with the potential to also prevent coronary heart disease and strokes. He currently is working to develop a new therapeutic approach to breast cancer maintenance so that women diagnosed with breast cancer can live their normal life spans.

Jordan's many honors include being appointed in 2019 to be Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George by Queen Elizabeth II for his services to women's health.

HONORARY DEGREE

Dr. Michael G. Moore



Named as "one of the 128 most important, influential, innovative, and interesting thinkers on education of all time" (*The Routledge Encyclopaedia of Educational Thinkers*, 2016), Michael G. Moore is recognized internationally for establishing the scholarly study of distance education and for pioneering the methods of teaching online.

A graduate of the London School of Economics, Moore spent seven early years in East Africa where he developed a lifelong commitment to creating alternative forms of education, especially adult education, as the means of opening opportunity to the economically and socially deprived. Arriving in Madison as a graduate student in 1970, he undertook an analysis of such programs, developing a theory and definition of what he referred to as "distance education" in his doctoral dissertation. Today, the field is widely referred to as e-learning and online learning. His doctorate was awarded by UW–Madison in 1976.

As a visiting professor in UW's Department of Continuing and Vocational Education in 1979 and again between 1984 and 1986, he designed and taught the first graduate-level seminars in the discipline in the US and probably the world.


Many other firsts followed. Moore proposed and helped plan the first national conference on distance education at UW–Madison in 1985. The conference continues to be held each summer at UW. He established the American Center for the Study of Distance Education at Pennsylvania State University, and he launched the *American Journal of Distance Education*.

Moore has traveled to more than 30 countries to advocate for distance learning and has played a significant role in developing distance education programs in Latin America, Scandinavia, Asia, and Africa. During his tenure as a visiting scholar at the World Bank, he led the development of some of the first international courses online.

Moore served on the faculty of The Open University in the United Kingdom, and Penn State. He retired from Penn State in 2013 as a distinguished professor emeritus of education.

ALUMNI SPEAKER

John Felder



As alumni speaker for winter commencement this year, John Felder speaks on behalf of the many students who participated in the Black Student Strike of 1969 at UW–Madison. The strike unfolded over two weeks in February and involved black students and thousands of their allies protesting what they considered meager progress by the university's administration on race-related campus goals.

The students held rallies, boycotted classes, marched to the state Capitol, took over lecture halls, and blocked building entrances. It was among the largest protests in the university's history. Felder helped organize the strike and served as one of its spokespeople.

Among its many outcomes, the strike is credited with leading to the creation in 1970 of the Afro-American Studies Department, one of the first such departments in the country. As it celebrates its 50th anniversary on campus this academic year, the department is being praised for contributions both academic and social. It is valued for its scholarship, but also for attracting a more diverse student and faculty population to campus and for educating the entire student body about race and racism.

Felder, born and raised in New York City, came to UW–Madison in 1968 on a scholarship that was part of a campus diversity initiative. He earned a bachelor's degree in economics history from UW–Madison in 1974. Early in his career, he taught freshman orientation classes at Hunter College in Manhattan. He spent 23 years as an administrator with Teamsters Union Local 237 in New York, retiring in 2008 as director of membership. He resides in Brooklyn, New York, where he creates folk art sculptures. His early avocational pursuits included freelance art criticism for *The New York Amsterdam News*.

STUDENT SPEAKER

Sven Kleinhans



Four years ago, Sven Kleinhans began his journey in higher education by moving from his native Germany to the US for his studies.

Recruited in 2016 to play soccer at Bluefield College in Bluefield, Virginia, Kleinhans earned two bachelor's degrees in three years at the Baptist liberal arts college—one in exercise sports science, the other in criminal justice.

With one year left of collegiate sports eligibility, Kleinhans came to UW–Madison in the fall of 2019 on a soccer scholarship. At the same time, he began a graduate program at the School of Education.

Red-shirted for the fall 2019 soccer season, Kleinhans, a goalkeeper, was looking forward to his final year of collegiate soccer eligibility this fall when COVID-19 forced the postponement of the season. As the student speaker for winter commencement, Kleinhans says he'll draw on this experience and others in discussing the need for resilience.

"This last year has been such a roller coaster, with so many ups and downs," he says. "My advice is to never give up, never have any regrets, and never lose focus on what really matters: the other people in your life."

As a teenager, he was briefly homeless with his mother and two younger siblings after his parents filed for divorce. The four had to leave their home at night, carrying everything they owned in a van. They bunked in tight quarters with friends for a time.

"The circumstances were quite difficult, but what stuck with me was the importance, as a family, of being able to trust each other and help each other out," he says.

Kleinhans is graduating with a master's degree in educational leadership and policy analysis. He plans to pursue a law degree in the fall of 2021, with hopes of becoming an FBI officer specializing in behavior analysis.

The Senior Class Officers comprise two elected officers, the President and Vice President, and three selected officers, the Communications, Events, and Philanthropy Directors. Elections and interviews took place in the spring semester prior to the beginning of their service in the fall of their senior year.

Part of the Division of Student Life, the officers also partner with the Wisconsin Foundation and Alumni Association (WFAA) and the Office of the Chancellor. The Senior Class Officers plan spring and winter commencement as well as senior social events and senior week events in cooperation with WFAA.

The University of Wisconsin-Madison

he University of Wisconsin–Madison and its alumni have a rich tradition of national and international leadership in teaching, research, entrepreneurship, and public service. We regularly rank near the top in research dollars and are rated among the strongest in the world in international reputation. And, as any visitor can readily attest, our beautiful lakeshore campus is considered to be among the nation's most picturesque.

This university has existed for as long as Wisconsin has been a state, tracing its roots to a clause in the Constitution of the State of Wisconsin decreeing that the young state should have a prominent public university. In 1848, legislators passed a bill that formally created the University of Wisconsin. Its first class, with 17 students, met in Madison on February 5, 1849.

From these humble beginnings, the university has grown into a large, diverse community with more than 45,500 students representing every county in Wisconsin, 50 states, and 126 countries.

Across campus, the words "sifting and winnowing" often appear when describing UW–Madison's intellectual life. They date back to an 1894 Board of Regents statement on academic freedom:

"Whatever may be the limitations which trammel inquiry elsewhere, we believe that the great state University of Wisconsin should ever encourage that continual and fearless sifting and winnowing by which alone the truth can be found."

Inspired by this spirit, scholarly inquiry has fed a steady stream of discoveries. From vitamins, agricultural techniques and wildlife ecology to stem cells, biofuels and economic well-being, the university continues to foster ideas and research that change lives.

UW–Madison is the oldest and largest campus in the University of Wisconsin System. Its mission is to provide "a learning environment in which faculty, staff, and students can discover, examine critically, preserve and transmit the knowledge, wisdom, and values that will help ensure the survival of this and future generations and improve the quality of life for all."

The university strives to achieve these ends through the continual advancement of its teaching, research, and public service programs. Throughout its history, the university has sought to bring the power of learning into students' daily lives through innovations such as residential learning communities and service learning courses.

We are motivated by the "Wisconsin Idea"—articulated a century ago as the principle that the university's influence should benefit everyone in the state. Today, this principle has expanded to a global scale. The Wisconsin Idea continues to permeate everything we do, helping to forge close partnerships between faculty, staff, and students, and people, communities, and industries around the world.

Academic Attire

Gowns

Gowns represent the three principal levels of academic achievement. The bachelor's gown, symbolizing the first degree, is made of black material and has a closed front and long, pointed, open sleeves. Master's candidates wear a black gown with a closed front and long, closed sleeves. The gown worn by doctoral candidates has an open front with bell-shaped sleeves. Doctoral gowns are further embellished with velvet trim in the form of crossbars on the sleeves. In spring 2017, the gown designs were updated to include the University of Wisconsin-Madison colors and crest logo, providing both a pop of red among the traditional sea of black and an additional display of UW spirit that's recognizable to all.

Hoods

Academic hoods are used as a further means of identifying the level of degree attainment. The bachelor's hood, worn only by those who have previously received a baccalaureate degree, is rather short with a narrow velvet edging the color of the appropriate discipline and a lining in the color of the institution cardinal at Wisconsin. The master's hood is considerably longer, has a wider velvet edging and exposes more of the lining. Doctoral hoods have the widest velvet edging, wide panels at either side, greater length, and a fully exposed lining.

Caps and Tassels

Candidates for the bachelor's degree wear the black mortarboard cap with tassels of their course color. The tassel is worn on the right side until the formal conferral of the degree. At that time, the tassel is moved from the right to the left side. Candidates for the Law JD and SJD degrees wear an 8-sided black tam with a gold tassel. Candidates for all advanced degrees wear black mortarboard caps with black tassels on the left side. Some holders of degrees from other countries or institutions wear special hats which are distinctive to their degree. Graduates displaying the red and white philanthropy cord have chosen to make a financial gift commitment of support to the university.

Honors

Bachelor's degree candidates with distinctive scholastic achievement wear cardinal stoles over the fronts of their gowns. Bachelor's degree candidates participating in an honors program wear white stoles with cardinal bars.




